



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The TBT Agreement

Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade

The TBT Agreement seeks to ensure that technical regulations, standards and conformity assessment procedures adopted by countries do not create unnecessary trade barriers.

Do not discriminate between similar products.


Recognizes the rights of countries to take measures as appropriate to protect legitimate objectives (health, safety, environment, etc.).

It urges countries to use international standards where appropriate, but they are not required to change their levels of protection as a result of standardization.

Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade

Regulators: MINSA, MINEM, PRODUCE, MINAM, MIDAGRI, etc.

The WTO TBT Agreement applies to three types of measures:




Excluded from the TBT scope are government purchases, services and sanitary and phytosanitary measures.

COMMITTEE ON TECHNICAL BARRIERS TO TRADE

13.1 A Committee on Technical Barriers to Trade is hereby established, which shall be composed of representatives of each Member. The Committee shall elect its Chairman and meet as appropriate, but at least once a year (...)

Two fundamental aspects:

- Examination of Specific Measures: To discuss STC on specific laws, regulations or procedures. More than 500 STC's have been raised to date.
- ☐ Strengthen the application of the ATBT: Transparency, application of standards, conformity assessment, GRP. Adoption of Decisions and Recommendations.



TRANSPARENCY: PREPARATION AND NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE

TRANSPARENCY

For TRs and STC:

 Members must announce, through a notice in a publication, at a suitably early stage, their intention to introduce a new technical regulation (Art. 2.9.1) or a new Conformity Assessment Procedure (5.6.1.TBT).

For standards:

 The work program must be published every 6 months specifying the rules adopted and those to be adopted (Paragraph J Annex 3). An official publication must report the existence of such a program.


Andean Community Decision 827


Article 12:

Before the adoption of draft TR and STC, CAN Member Countries should allow other Members or any interested party to submit their comments in writing either by physical or electronic means, preferably through the Enquiry Point of the notifying Member Country. For which a minimum period of sixty (60) calendar days must be granted.


The Andean Community Notification and Technical Regulatory Information System (TRIS) established by Decision 615 should be used for notification.



Asimismo, una de las primeras opciones preventivas para manejar la dinámica de plagas y mantener un bajo umbral de daño económico en los sistemas de producción orgánica, es el uso de controladores biológicos. Además, esta práctica es difundida por el SENASA como Autoridad en Sanidad Agraria, pues fomenta la crianza y liberación de controladores biológicos, entre ellos los parásitos y depredadores de insectos plagas.


