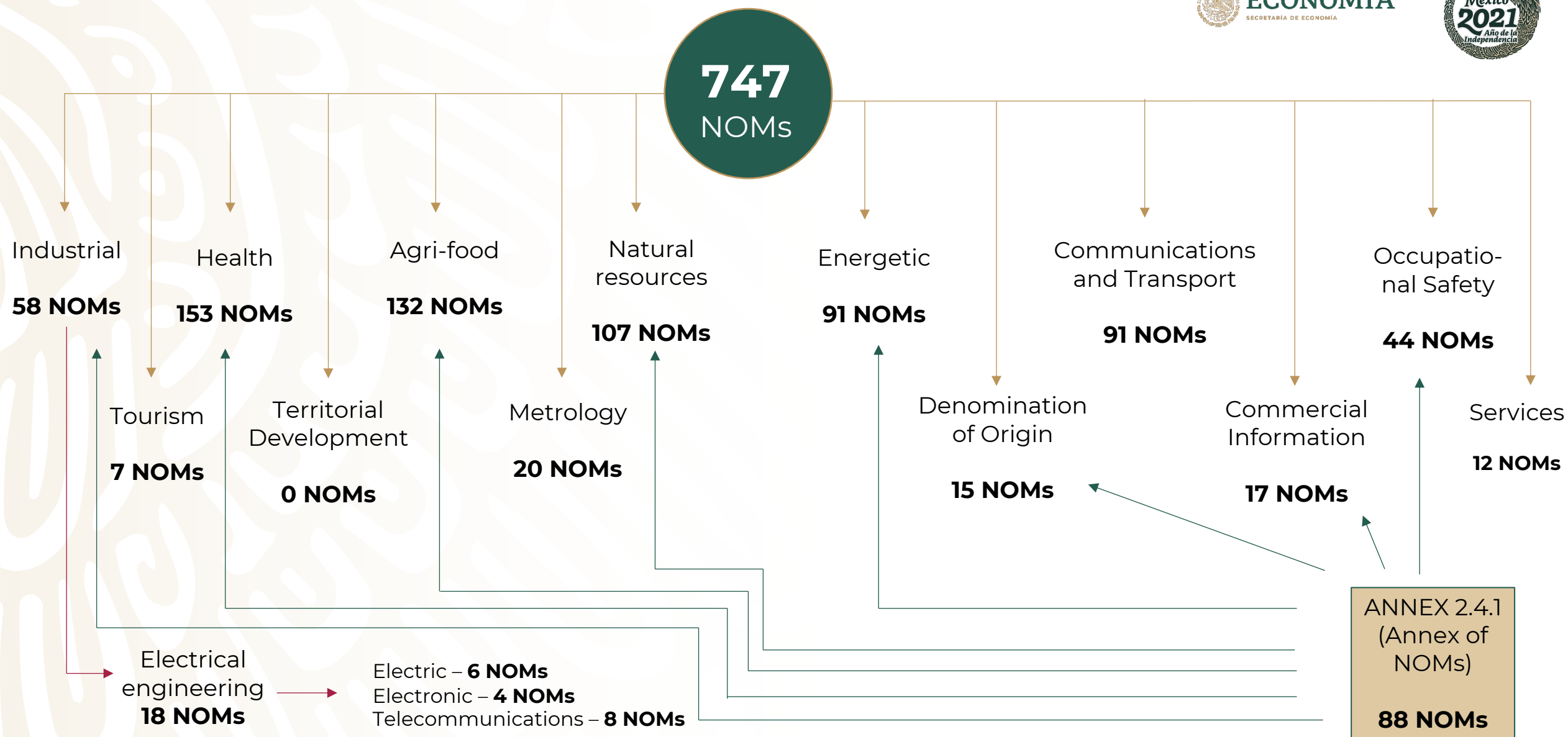
## Economic development actions

- ✓ Promote commercial transactions, improving global value chains.
- ✓ Support the transfer of technology that strengthens and expands the production plant.
- ✓ Promote technological innovation and research in the production of goods, processes and services.

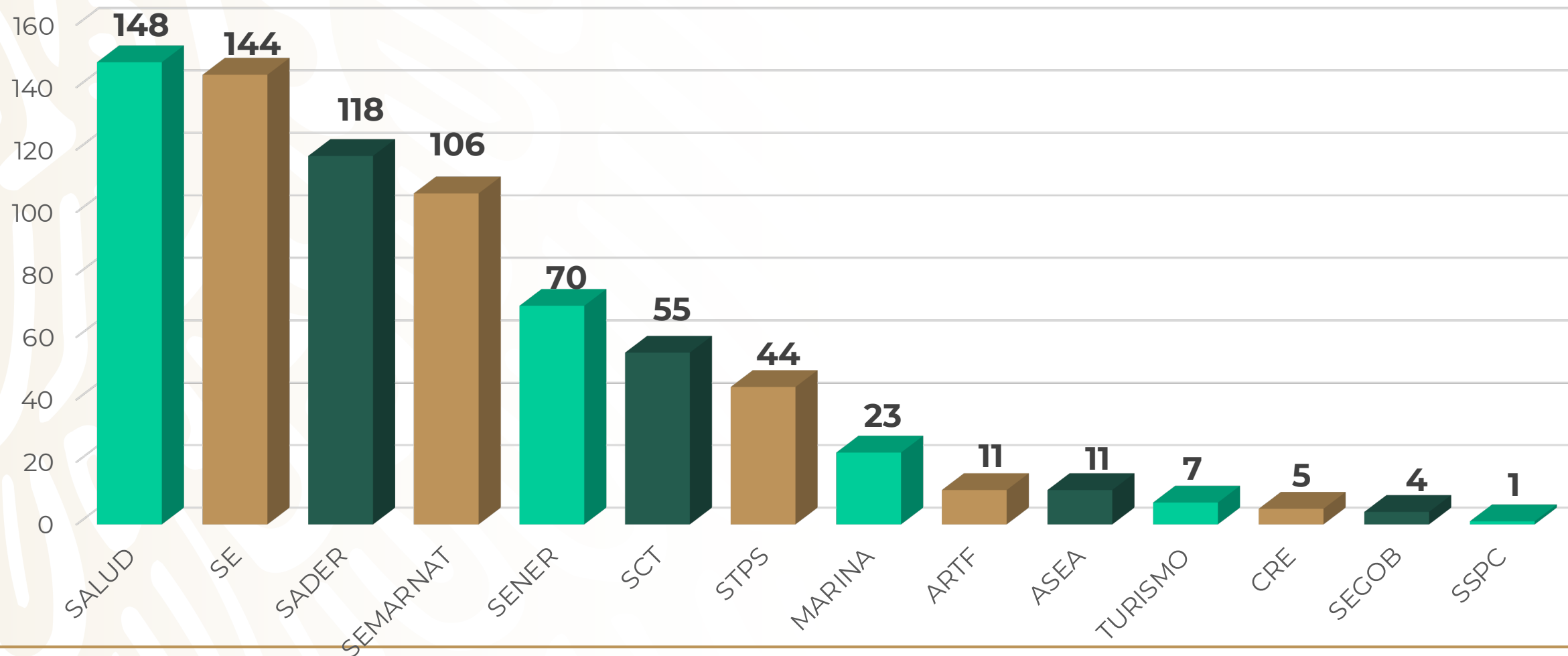

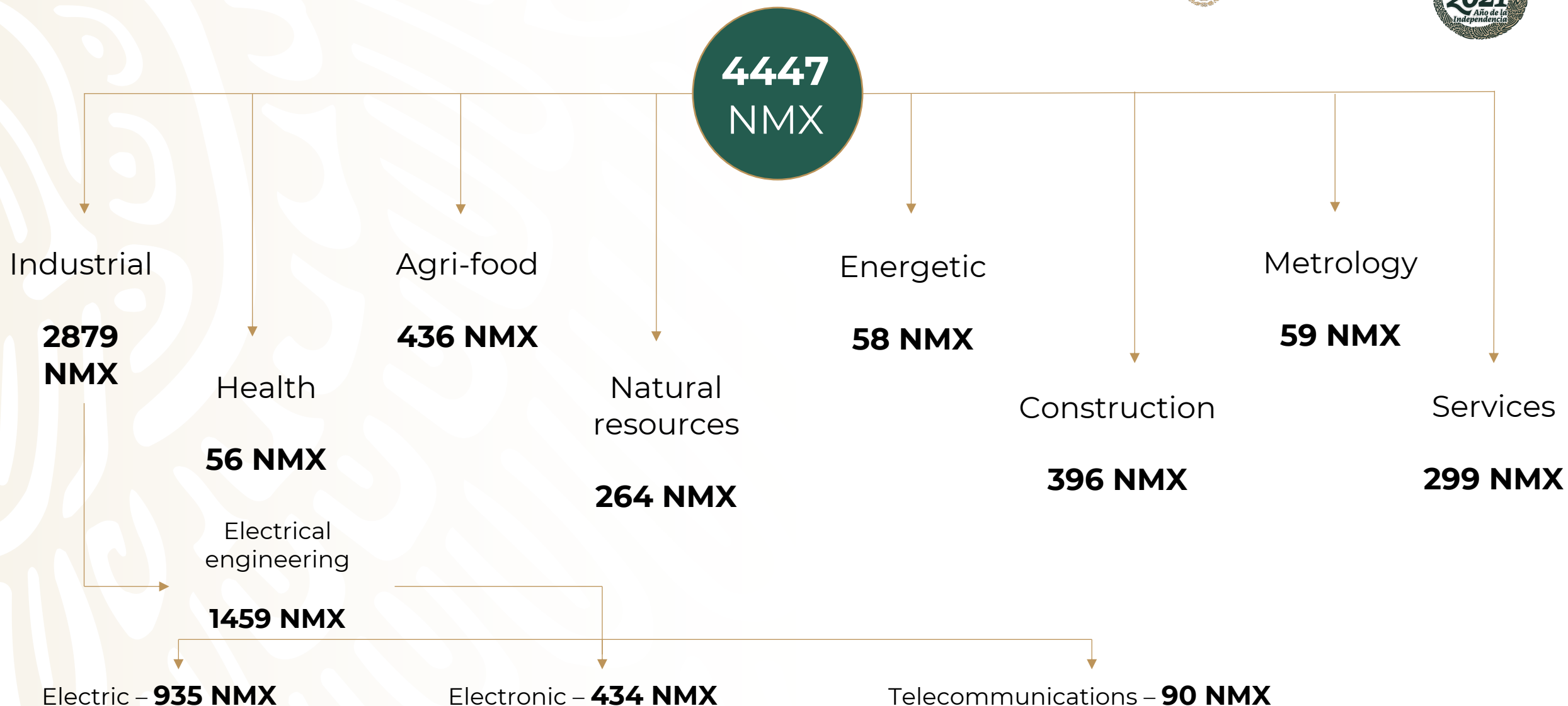

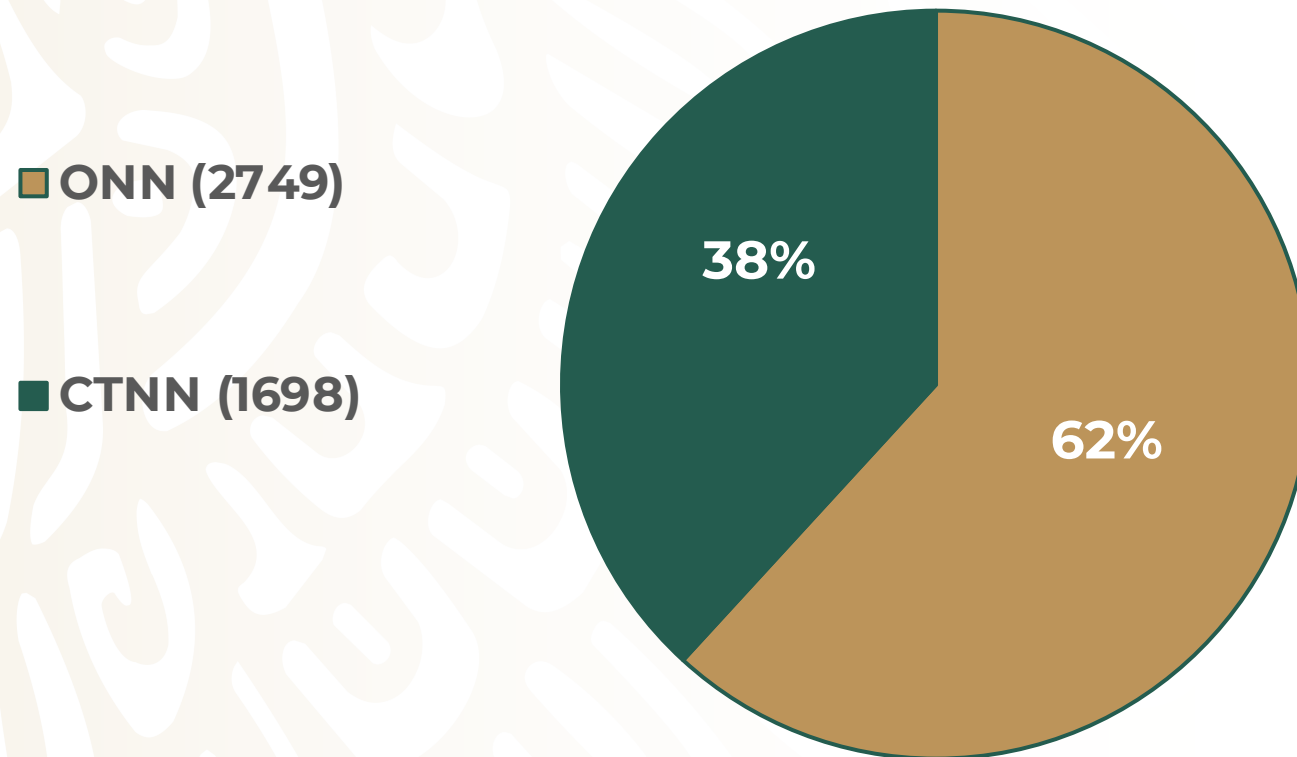

  - **Technological innovation** to improve people's quality of life.
  - Physical and digital infrastructure for **Conformity Assessment**.
  - Promote scientific, legal and industrial **Metrology**, as well as the creation of **Designated Metrology Institutes**.

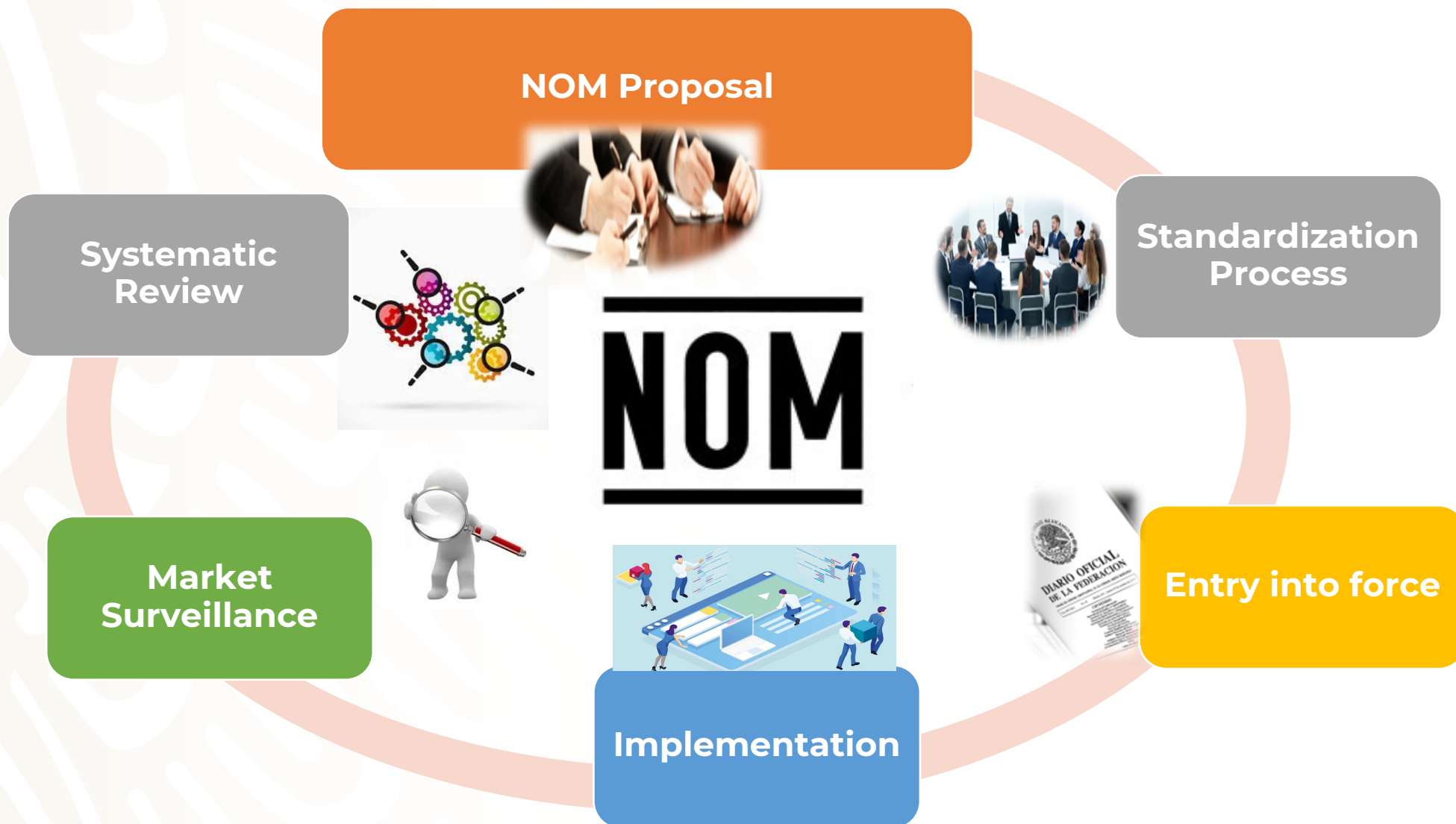


# Protects Legitimate Objectives of Public Interest (OLIP).

- ✓ The system protects the fundamental rights entitled in the Constitution and in international treaties.
- ✓ It establishes adequate measures for the protection of Health, Safety, Environment, Education, Right to Information, Food, among others.
- ✓ Addresses the causes of the problems identified by the Standardization Authorities that affect or put at risk the OLIP.
- ✓ Each Unit of the Federal Public Administration has an area of competence for its protection.



# Regulatory Policy Cycle

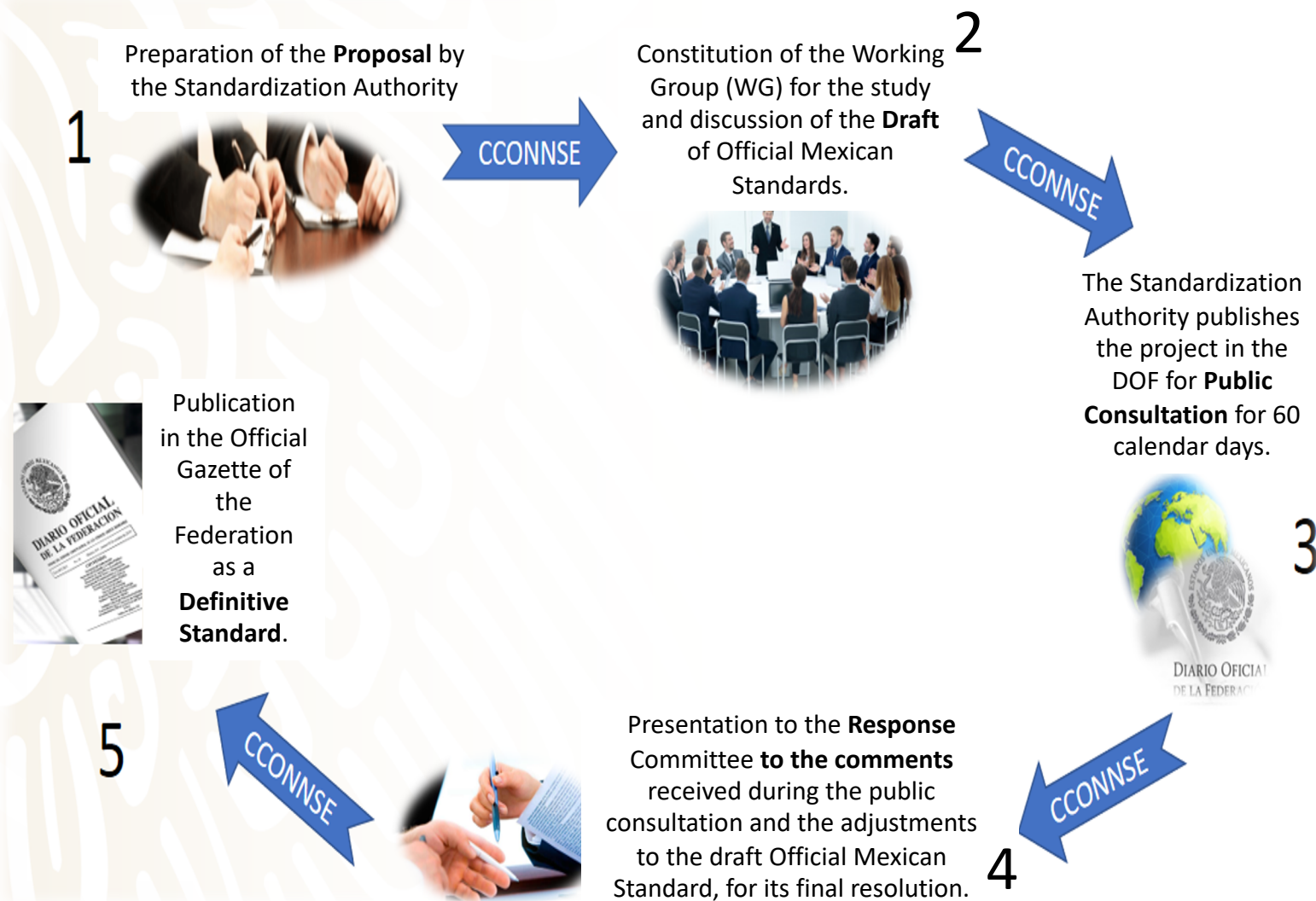




# Standardization Process

## How does it work?

- ✓ Progressive and successive stages.
- ✓ Dialectical scheme.
- ✓ NOMs evolve over time along with the process of regulatory improvement
- ✓ The IASB determines the coordination mechanism between the different Standardizing Authorities when their competences affect.



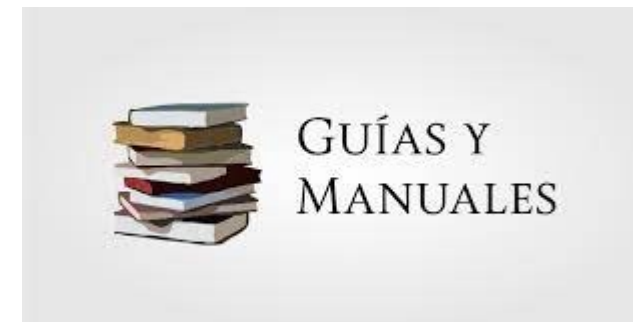

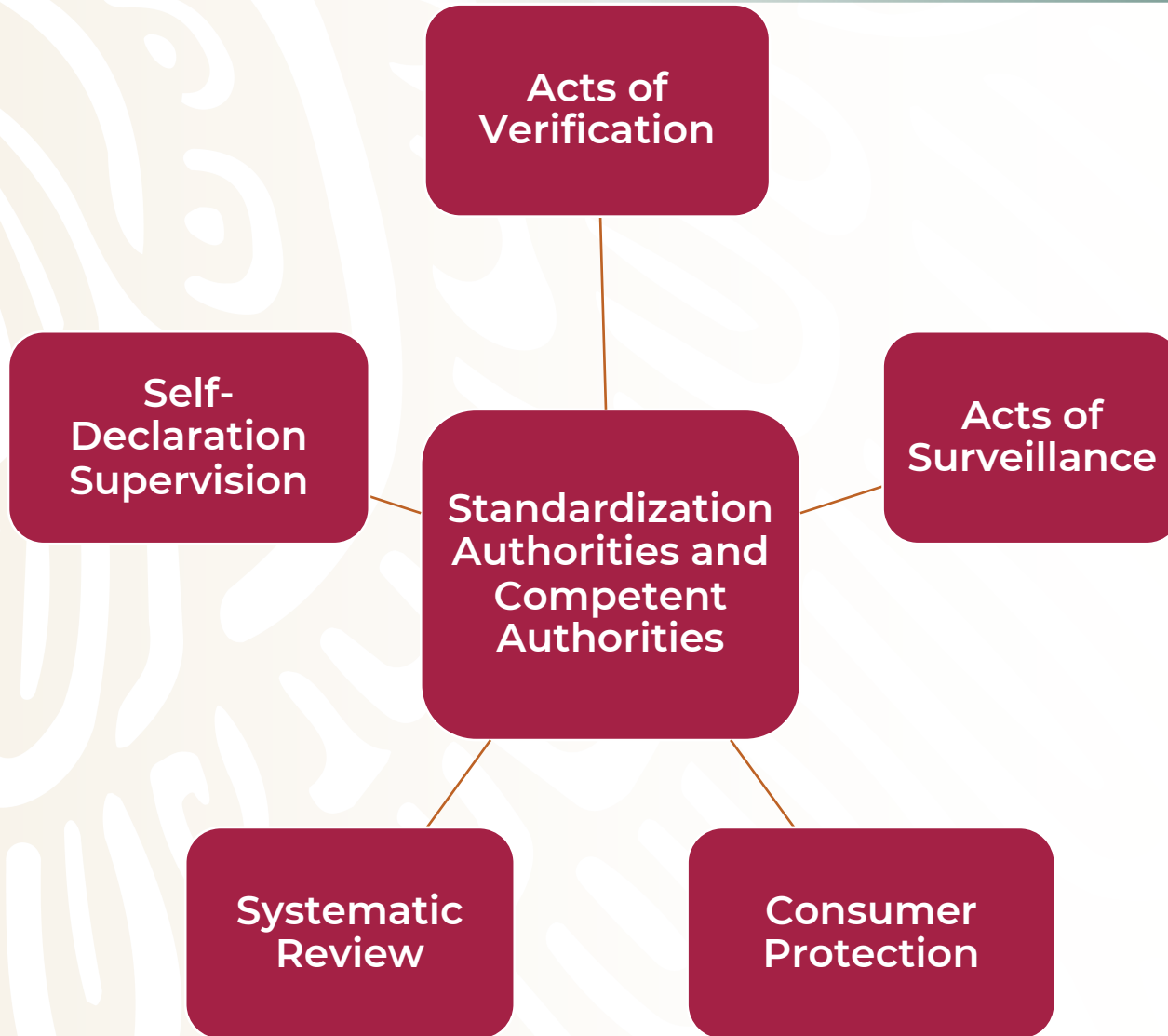
