TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Technical documents setting out the characteristics of a product or the production processes and methods related thereto, including the applicable administrative provisions the observance of which is mandatory

The OFFICIAL MEXICAN STANDARDS will be considered as Technical Regulations or Sanitary or Phytosanitary Measures, as they fit into the corresponding definitions provided for in the international treaties to which the Mexican State is a party.



OFFICIAL MEXICAN STANDARD

Technical regulation of mandatory observance issued by the competent Standardization Authorities whose essential purpose is the promotion of quality for economic development and the protection of the legitimate objectives of public interest provided for in the Law, through the establishment of rules, denomination, specifications or characteristics applicable to a good, product, process or service, as well as those related to terminology, marking or labeling and information.



REGULATORY IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

WHAT IS REGULATORY IMPROVEMENT?

Regulatory improvement is a public policy that consists of the generation of clear rules, simplified procedures and services, as well as effective institutions for their creation and application, which are aimed at obtaining the greatest possible value from the available resources and the optimal functioning of commercial, industrial, productive, service and human development activities of society as a whole.



PURPOSE

- Seek the greatest benefits for society with the lowest possible costs, through the regulatory formulation of rules and incentives that stimulate innovation, confidence in the economy, productivity and efficiency in favor of the growth and general well-being of society.
- Raise the levels of productivity and economic growth in states and municipalities of the country, by reducing obstacles and costs for entrepreneurs and citizens at the time they carry out their activities.



THE RIA

Regulatory Impact Analysis is a public policy tool that aims to ensure that the benefits of regulations outweigh their costs. The RIA allows to systematically analyze the potential impacts of regulatory instruments for government decision-making, encouraging them to be more transparent and rational.
