Administers technical committees of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and U.S. Technical Advisory Groups (TAGs) to ISO




Administers technical committees of the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and U.S. Technical Advisory Groups (TAGs) to IEC



Develops American National Standards and technical reports




AAMI Standards philosophy

AAMI's role with ISO

- Secretariat for ISO/TC 121 (Anesthetic and respiratory equipment) and subcommittees 2, 3, 4, 6
- Secretariat for ISO/TC 150/SC 2 (Cardiovascular implants and extracorporeal systems) and ISO/TC 150/SC 6 (Active implants)

Other international role

 Secretary, ISO/TC 215 – IEC/SC 62A/Joint Working Group 7 (Safe, effective and secure health software and health IT systems, including those incorporating medical devices)




U.S. adoption of ISO or IEC standards

- The decision to propose adoption of an IEC or ISO standard is taken by an AAMI technical committee/working group.
- The committee may decide to adopt an International Standard, harmonize with an International Standard, or maintain a divergent standard.
- Adoptions require the same due process procedures as the development of other ANSI standard.






Types of Documents developed by AAMI

Sterilization – ANSI/AAMI ST79

Electrical safety – ANSI/AAMI ES60601-1

Human factors/usability – ANSI/AAMI HE75, ANSI/AAMI/IEC 62366

Quality systems/Risk management – ANSI/AAMI/ISO 13485, 14971, 24971

Biological evaluation – AAMI adoption of the ISO 10993 series

* Artificial intelligence – Consensus Report/Technical Information Report to be issued
