Accreditation

- Ensure that conformity assessment bodies (e.g. laboratories, inspection or certification bodies) have the technical capacity to perform their duties
- Used in regulated sectors and voluntary areas
- Increases trust in conformity assessment
- Reinforces the mutual recognition of products, services, systems, and bodies

- Sector-specific requirements
- Guidance

Standards supporting conformity assessment

- ISO COMMITTEE ON CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT (CASCO)
 - Develops policy and publishes standards related to conformity assessment
- ISO/IEC 17021-1:2015
 - Conformity assessment Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems — Part 1: Requirements
- ISO/IEC 17021-3:2017
 - Conformity assessment Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems — Part 3: Competence requirements for auditing and certification of quality management systems

MDSAP assessment of Auditing Organizations

Initial assessment

- Application review
- Stage 1 Assessment including Documentation Review
- On-site assessment (Head Office)
- 3 Witnessed Audits
- On-site Assessment of all critical locations

Surveillance

- Surveillance on-site assessment (Head Office)
- 1 Witnessed Audit
- 1 Witnessed Audit per critical location

Re-recognition

- Stage 1 Assessment including Documentation Review for changes
- Re-recognition on-site assessment (Head Office)
- 1 Witnessed Audit
- On-site Assessment of all critical locations
