 Standards are developed only when there is a need for them


- They are developed by technical committees (TC) governed by SABS
- TC member representative is any individual that is nominated by his/her organization to represent it in the committee

Standards are decided upon by way of consensus

- SABS TC 1039 is the technical committee for Medical devices
- SABS TC 1039 has 2 subcommittees under it
- The subcommittees covers sterilization and health care products and the general aspects for medical devices





- SABS TC 1039 and its subcommittees has a total of 52 published standards which covers surgical medical devices, syringes, medical gloves and the sterilization of health care product
- SABS TC 1039 and its subcommittees has a total of 9
 projects on the programme of work for adoptions of the
 ISO standards for biological evaluation of medical
