Patient Barriers to MedTech

- Tax/Tariffs
- Customs/Import Licensing
- Regulatory (Including Standards & CA)
 - Access/Payment/Reimbursement/Procurement
 - Ethics



Trade Barriers in 4 Numbers

5% - Average Global Import Tariffs (pre-2025)

10% - Inefficient Customs Costs - Tariff Equivalence (NTB)



20% - Duplicative Regulatory Costs - Tariff Equivalence (NTB)

10-30% - Ethics Costs - Tariff Equivalence (NTB)

NTBs = 40-60% Tariff Equivalence (8-12 times tariff average)



Trade Barrier Lowering Mechanisms

- Tariffs Tariff Negotiations / MFN & Agreements
- Customs WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement (TFA)



- Regulatory WTO Technical Barriers to Trade Agreement (TBT)
- Procurement WTO Government Procurement Agreement (GPA)



Technical Barriers to Trade (TBTs) (Challenge)

- Duplicative Regulatory Costs derive from:
 - National Technical Regulations that are:
 - Overly-Trade Restrictive because they are not based upon:
 - International Standards and
 - Global Conformity Assessment Procedures
 - And may therefore constitute Technical Barriers to Trade (& Health!)
 - Which are Non-Tariff Barriers



Technical Barriers to Trade (TBTs) (Solution)

- Duplicative Regulatory Costs may be minimized by having:
 - National Technical Regulations be:
 - Not More Trade Restrictive than Necessary by being based upon:
 - International Standards and
 - Global Conformity Assessment Procedures
 - Thereby preventing and removing Technical Barriers to Trade (&Health!)
 - Which are Non-Tariff Barriers



Technical Barriers to Trade (TBTs) Recommendations (Private Sector)

- Familiarize yourself with the <u>WTO/TBT Agreement</u>
- Use <u>ePing</u> system
- Submit Comments / Develop Specific Trade Concerns
- Be engaged in <u>international and national medtech standardization efforts</u>
- Include TBT, Standards and Conformity Assessment considerations in domestic public consultations and engagements with regulatory authorities
- Be coherent: Align local comments with global comments



Technical Barriers to Trade (TBTs) Recommendations (Public Sector)

- Implement whole-of-government <u>Good Regulatory Practice (GRP)</u> policies
- Implement Standard Operating Procedures within Regulatory Agencies and Government Bodies that implement GRP and TBT commitments
- Be engaged in <u>international and national medtech standardization efforts</u>
- Base national Technical Regulations and Conformity Assessment Procedures on International Standards and Global Practices
- Notify all draft and final measures to the WTO
- Modify draft measures based on comments received to comport with WTO
